Tiny Planet Produce is located in the St. Croix River Valley on a 20 acre farm. This is the 2nd year offering a C.S.A. share. A total of **40 full shares** are available. We offer rational portions of a wide range of varieties of in-season produce. Only the best tasting and most beautiful veggies will be included in your box, and will always practice pesticide & chemical-free growing.

JOIN US IN OUR GROWING EXPERIENCE

The season starts with seeding bedding plants and onions in February. Field work starts in April, along with prepping for our Bedding Plants Sales. We grow a variety of annuals along with a few winter-hardy perennials. We begin transplanting and seeding in the field around the end of April and will not stop until the frost prohibits us to continue in October. We grow 7 acres of mixed veggies which provide for a diversified C.S.A. and will sustain two farmers markets. We sell at the Kingfield Farmers Market and the St. Croix Falls, WI Farmers Market.

WE SPECIALIZE IN THE STAPLES:

Here is how it will go:

SPRING: Broccoli, Spinach, Lettuce, Scallions, Radishes, Turnips, Kohlrabi, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Snap Peas, Herbs, Salad Mix, Asian Greens, Garlic Scapes, Tomatoes, Green Beans, Onions, New Potatoes, Carrots, Beets, Kale and Swiss Chard.

SUMMER: Eggplant, Peppers, Tomatoes, Corn, Melons, Storage Onions, Summer Squash, Cucumbers, Garlic, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Specialty Greens, Spinach, Lettuce, Radishes, and Turnips.

FALL: Winter Squash, Dried Herbs, Storage Onions, Storage Potatoes, Turnips, Kale, Leeks, Parsnips, Spinach, Garlic, Carrots, Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Beets and Pumpkins.

C.S.A. OR COMMUNITY.SUPPORTED.AGRICULTURE

You, the community, buy a share of the season. Your support helps buy seeds, greenhouse supplies, gas for tractors and delivery supplies. You then become part of our growing season, experiencing the abundance along with the bumps in the road. With your help, we will deliver 17 weeks to your doorstep, a neighborhood drop location or on-farm Pick-up. **Prices vary as to which delivery option you choose:**

BOX SIZE AND INFORMATION

We use offer FULL & SINGLE SHARES, which will include:

- FULL SHARES: 3/4 Bushel Box of 8-12 in-season fresh-picked veggie varieties, weighing between 10- 30 lbs. This is enough for a veggie loving family of 4 or 2 families to split!
- SINGLE SHARES: 5/9 Bushel Box filled with 6-10 veggies varieties of smaller portions for a single person or 2 people sharing. A great supplement to your own garden or farmer's market!
- Newsletter with farm updates, recipes and food saving techniques.
- The Season runs 17 weeks and usually starts the beginning to middle of June.
- A Neighborhood drop is created by you. Get together and create a spot to save some money!
- All members are invited to join us on the farm for our fall harvest party. Pick your own pumpkin, enjoy some farm fresh food and meet the members.
- We do offer Fall Shares when available, our members get first dibs.
