JOIN US IN OUR GROWING EXPERIENCE

We begin transplanting and seeding in the field early in the spring and will not stop until the frost prohibits us to continue in late fall. We grow a wide variety of different vegetables which provide for diversified selection for our customers.

WE SPECIALIZE IN THE STAPLES:

Here are some of the items you might expect to find and roughly when they will be available:
SPRING: Broccoli, Spinach, Lettuce, Scallions, Radishes, Turnips, Kohlrabi, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Snap Peas, Herbs, Salad Mix, Asian Greens, Garlic Scapes, Carrots, Beets, Kale and Swiss Chard.

SUMMER: Tomatoes, Basil, Green Beans, Onions, New Potatoes, Eggplant, Peppers, Corn, Melons, Summer Squash, Cucumbers, Garlic, Broccoli, Specialty Greens, Spinach, Lettuce, Radishes, and Turnips.

FALL: Winter Squash, Dried Herbs, Storage Onions, Storage Potatoes, Turnips, Kale, Leeks, Spinach, Salad Mix, Asian Greens, Garlic, Carrots, Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Beets and Pumpkins.

C.S.A. OR COMMUNITY.SUPPORTED.AGRICULTURE

When you join our C.S.A. you pre-purchase veggies which help us with spring farming expenses. In return you receive credit to use towards veggies or plant starts at the Farmer's Market of your choice. Your support helps buy seeds, greenhouse supplies, gas for tractors and market supplies. You then become part of our growing season, experiencing the abundance along with the bumps in the road. Unlike how we've run our C.S.A. in previous years each week you will choose what you want to eat or not eat! There is no box assigned to you.

MARKET SHARE INFORMATION

We offer MARKET SHARES, which will include:

- A discount for pre-purchasing veggies from your local farmer!
- Newsletter with farm updates, pictures, recipes and food saving techniques.
- The Season runs the length of the market season, starting mid May to the end of October. Roughly 25 weeks.
- All members are invited to join us on the farm for our fall harvest party. Pick your own pumpkin, enjoy some farm fresh food and meet other members.
- Members get informed when "canning boxes" are available before the market.
